The new site was created to make it easy to locate the information you need. All of the site's clinical content was written by Madonna's interdisciplinary team of rehabilitation specialists.

To help others understand the patient experience at Madonna, the Web site features videos of former patients sharing their inspirational stories of recovery through rehabilitation. Take an online photo tour of the hospital to view the Therapy Gym, Commons Café, Chapel or Aquatherapy Pool. Learn about how Madonna was founded and the core values that ensure all patients are treated with exceptional care and compassion.

The home page features an introduction to Madonna, as well as quick access to admissions and referral information, career opportunities, giving and volunteering, news and events, the Research Institute, patient care programs, specialized services, TherapyPlus outpatient programs, ProActive health and fitness, extended care and clinical education.

Detailed information about Madonna's accredited rehabilitation programs is quickly accessible and

includes a definition of the program and who is served, outcome data, clinical leadership and an overview of a typical day in the program. Peer to Peer contacts can also be made online so current or prospective patients can visit with others who have shared the same type of experience.

For physicians and discharge planners, the online referral application and admissions information simplifies the transfer process. Insurance information and helpful resources for families are also available in this section of the site.

An important part of selecting a care provider is knowing who is on the medical team. Madonna's physicians, program managers and key clinicians

are featured on the Web site, including their educational backgrounds and areas of expertise.

News and press releases are continually updated on the site and visitors can subscribe online to receive bi-monthly issues of *The Madonna Independent* by email or other specialty newsletters. Archives of newsletters are available on the site for reference.
