

## Acquired Apraxia of Speech: Examining the Relationship between Treatment & Generalization Outcomes

The aim of treatment is long term maintenance of treated stimuli as well as generalization of treated stimuli to other contexts and similar stimuli not directly treated. However, generalization is not always examined in conjunction with treatment outcomes. This investigation examined the relationship between treatment and generalization outcomes following treatment. Twenty individuals with chronic AOS and aphasia received Sound Production Treatment in two conditions of practice (blocked & random). Correlational analyses were conducted to examine the relationship between treatment and generalization outcomes. Preliminary findings revealed patterns of performance differed for treatment and generalization outcomes based conditions of practice.
