



MADONNA (MRH) INPATIENT STROKE PROGRAM OUTCOMES

392 NUMBER OF PEOPLE SERVED

392 people were served by acute rehabilitation, **235** in Omaha and **157** in Lincoln. **135** had left brain strokes, **147** had right brain strokes, **8** had bilateral strokes and the remaining **102** had no paresis or other causes for their stroke.

The average age was **67.2** years old, including **12** children and adolescents.

WHERE PATIENTS COME FROM

Hospitals throughout the United States refer patients with a stroke to Madonna. Last year, more than **23.6%** of stroke patients came from areas outside of Nebraska.

AVERAGE THERAPY HOURS

Last year, people with a stroke had an average of **3.8 hours** of physical, occupational, speech, rehabilitation psychology, and/or recreational therapy per day, 5 days a week, delivered by licensed therapists.

As appropriate, patients may also receive respiratory and nutrition therapy.

DISCHARGE TO HOME/COMMUNITY

67.6% of people with stroke at our acute rehabilitation hospitals discharged to a community setting.

PATIENT SATISFACTION

95.3% of people with stroke rated their overall experience as excellent or good.





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
TRANSFERS TO ACUTE

Madonna is a hospital with clinical staff on-site 24 hours a day, seven days per week. Clinical staff are trained to respond to any medical emergency.

Last year, **38** individuals (9.7%) with a stroke transferred to acute care and **29** of those were for unplanned reasons. This is significantly less than other hospitals in the region (10.4%) and nation (10.8%).

INDEPENDENCE LEVEL


Patients recovering from stroke at Madonna made similar gains (23.6 points) compared to the nation (23.3 points) as measured by the “Self-Care and Mobility Activities” tool. This progress is calculated by rating activities such as mobility, self-cares, communication and cognition on a scale of 1-6 and totaling the categories.



LENGTH OF STAY

Individuals with a stroke stayed at Madonna’s acute rehab an average of **22.9** days.


FOLLOW UP 6 MONTHS AFTER DISCHARGE



92.1% of people with stroke state that they maintained or improved since their discharge in areas such as self-cares, mobility, communication and thinking skills.



94.2% of people with stroke state that they are able to access the things they need in their community.



65.7% of people with stroke have returned to work or school.
