



MADONNA REHABILITATION DAY PROGRAM - LINCOLN

Madonna Rehabilitation Day Program (RDP) is coordinated outpatient therapy dedicated to help adults and children with a physical or cognitive disability learn to function more independently in their home and community. RDP provides an intense and holistically oriented approach that includes medical monitoring, coordinated therapies and education.

AVERAGE AMOUNT OF THERAPY

Treatment plans are designed to meet individual needs and payer rules. The following illustrates the average number of visits received last year:

The average age was 39 years old, including 13 children and adolescents.

Many individuals also received recreational therapy, social work services, rehabilitation nursing, neuropsychology and/or nutrition services as part of RDP.

PATIENT SATISFACTION

94% of RDP patients rated their overall experience as “Excellent.”

98% of RDP patients said they would “definitely” recommend Madonna TherapyPlus to family and friends.





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INDEPENDENCE LEVEL

Patients in Madonna's Rehabilitation Day Program made more progress toward gains in areas including cognitive, behavioral, communication and community functioning. Improvement is measured using the Functional Assessment Measure (FAM). Average discharge FAM was 173, modified independent to supervision. Average FAM gain was 22.

LENGTH OF STAY

Last year adults attended RDP for an average of 20 non-consecutive days. Children and adolescents attended an average of 22 non-consecutive days. Patients are seen 3-5 days per week while in RDP.

DISCHARGE

Many individuals will require intermittent outpatient therapy after their discharge from RDP. Depending upon where you live, this could occur here or in your home community.

ACCREDITATION

Yes, by CARF, the Rehabilitation Accreditation Commission, as an Outpatient Medical Rehabilitation Program, Brain Injury Specialty Program, Stroke Specialty Program, Spinal Cord Injury Specialty Program and Pediatric Specialty Program. In April 2018 Madonna earned the highest accreditation level possible - three years.
