



MADONNA REHABILITATION HOSPITAL LINCOLN (MRHL)

Madonna Rehabilitation Hospital Lincoln (MRHL) is appropriate for individuals who require intense medical rehabilitation for a longer period of time than generally occurs in the acute care hospital.

The average age was **52** years old, including **64** children and adolescents.

Unlike most other rehabilitation settings in Nebraska, MRH-L has specialized rehabilitation units for persons with brain injury, spinal cord injury, and for adolescents and children. Physicians, rehabilitation nurses, and therapists who are assigned to these units have expertise treating people and these diagnoses.

AVERAGE THERAPY HOURS

Last year, people served in MRHL had an average of **3.4 hours** of physical, occupational, speech, rehabilitation psychology, and/or recreation therapy per day delivered by licensed therapists. As appropriate, you may also receive respiratory and nutrition therapy as well.

LENGTH OF STAY

Individuals at MRHL stayed an average of **31** days.

PATIENT SATISFACTION

95% of patients rated their overall experience as excellent or good and **97%** said they would definitely recommend MRHL to family or friends.



WHERE PATIENTS COME FROM

Last year, more than **46%** of patients were admitted to MRHL from hospitals outside of Nebraska.



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HOW OFTEN WILL I SEE A DOCTOR

You will be seen several days per week by a physiatrist, a doctor who specializes in rehabilitation, and as needed by physicians with other specialties such as internal medicine, pulmonary and others.

TRANSFERS TO ACUTE

Madonna is a hospital with clinical staff on-site 24 hours a day, seven days per week. Clinical staff are trained to respond to any medical emergency. Individuals may return to acute care if their status warrants a transfer or for a planned procedure.

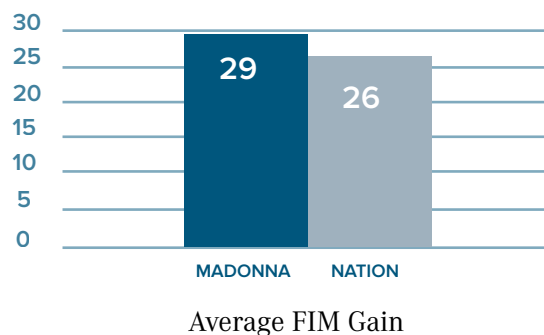
Last year **8.9%** of patients had unplanned returns to acute care. Overall, 10.6% of patients returned to acute care, including those for planned procedures, which is less than the national benchmark (11.8%).

DISCHARGE TO HOME/COMMUNITY

71% were discharged to a community setting.

INDEPENDENCE LEVEL

Patients in MRHL made higher functional gains in areas such as mobility, self cares, communication and cognition than the nation and discharged at a higher functional level overall (86 vs 80 total points).



ACCREDITATION

MRHL has accreditation from CARF International as a comprehensive integrated inpatient program, brain injury specialty program, spinal cord system of care, stroke specialty program and pediatric specialty program.
