How much experience does Madonna have treating people like me?

- Last year, Madonna served 282 persons with spinal cord injury, including 126 in the acute rehabilitation hospital (MRH).
- The average age was 47 years old.
- Unlike any other rehabilitation setting in Nebraska, MRH has a dedicated rehabilitation unit, staff and physician who care for persons who have had a spinal cord injury. You will interact daily with other people who have experienced a spinal cord injury and benefit from care delivered by a specialized spinal cord injury rehabilitation team.

Where do people come from?

Hospitals throughout the Midwest refer patients with spinal cord injury to Madonna. Last year, nearly 48% of patients with spinal cord injury came from areas outside Lincoln.

How much therapy will I have?

- Last year, people with spinal cord injury had an average 3.7 hours of physical, occupational, speech, psychology and/or recreational therapy per day delivered by licensed therapists.
- As appropriate, you may also receive respiratory and nutrition therapy.

How often will I see a doctor?

You will be seen several days per week by a physiatrist, a doctor who specializes in rehabilitation, and as needed by physicians with other specialties such as Internal Medicine, Pulmonology or others.

I have other medical problems. What happens if I get sick or have a medical emergency?

- Madonna is a hospital with clinical staff on-site 24 hours a day, seven days per week.
- Last year 7% of patients with spinal cord injury had unplanned discharges to acute care. Most were able to return to MRH and complete the program.

How long will I be at Madonna?

Individuals with paraplegia stayed at MRH an average of 46 days and individuals with tetraplegia stayed an average of 55 days.

What kinds of outcomes can I expect?

- 96% of inpatients with spinal cord injury met their predicted outcomes at discharge.
- 64% were discharged to a community setting.
- Patients with spinal cord injury made 24 points in functional gains which is competitive with the nation (24) and the region (26).

What do other people say about their experience at Madonna?

- 90% of patients with spinal cord injury rated their overall experience as excellent or good.
- 98% said they would "definitely" recommend Madonna's spinal cord injury rehabilitation program to family or friends.

Is Madonna accredited?


Yes, by CARF, the Rehabilitation Accreditation Commission, as a Spinal Cord System of Care. In April 2015 Madonna earned the highest accreditation level possible—three years.
