How much experience does Madonna have treating people like me?

- Last year, Madonna served 542 persons with stroke across all sites, including 158 in the acute rehabilitation hospital (MRH-L).
- The average age was 69.9 years.
- 54 people were 65 years or younger, including 3 children and adolescents.
- Unlike any other rehabilitation setting in Nebraska, MRH has a dedicated rehabilitation unit, staff and physician who care for persons who have had a stroke. You will interact daily with other people who have experienced a stroke and benefit from care delivered by a specialized stroke rehabilitation team.

Where do people come from?

Hospitals throughout the Midwest refer patients with stroke to Madonna. Last year, nearly 38% of patients with stroke came from areas outside Lincoln.

How much therapy will I have?

- Last year, people with stroke had an average of 3.9 hours of physical, occupational, speech, psychology and/or recreational therapy per day delivered by licensed therapists.
- As appropriate, you may also receive respiratory and nutrition therapy.

How often will I see a doctor?

You will be seen several days per week by a physiatrist, a doctor who specializes in rehabilitation, and as needed by physicians with other specialties such as Internal Medicine, Pulmonology or others.

I have other medical problems. What happens if I get sick or have a medical emergency?

- Madonna is a hospital with clinical staff on-site 24 hours a day, seven days per week.
- Last year 5.0% or 8 individuals with stroke had an unplanned discharge to acute care, which is significantly less than the nation (10.3%) and region (9.4%).

How long will I be at Madonna?

Individuals with stroke stayed an average of 22 days.

What kinds of outcomes can I expect?

- 76% of inpatients with stroke met their predicted outcomes at discharge.
- 57.6% were discharged to a community setting.
- Patients with stroke made 23.8 points in functional gains, which is equal to the nation and region, and discharged at 81.8 FIM points, which is higher than the nation (76.9) or region (78.8).

What do other people say about their experience at Madonna?

- 86.7% of patients with stroke rated their overall experience as excellent or good.
- 100% said they would “definitely” recommend Madonna’s stroke rehabilitation program to family or friends.

Is Madonna accredited?

Yes, by CARF, the Rehabilitation Accreditation Commission, as a Stroke Specialty Program. In April 2015 Madonna earned the highest accreditation level possible—three years.
