OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS

**Rehabilitation Day Program (RDP)**  
an intense, coordinated outpatient program

**Traditional Outpatient (OP)**  
Physical, Occupational and/or Speech  
Therapy 1-3 times per week. Rehabilitation  
Psychology available.

**Specialty Clinics and Assessments**  
specialized services focused on areas such  
as vision, swallowing, wheelchair mobility,  
communication or long term follow-up.

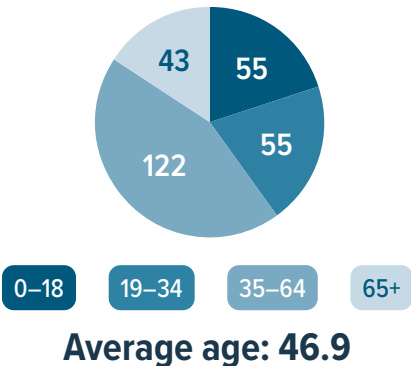

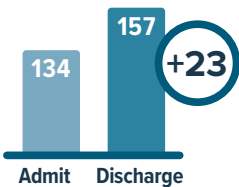
