OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS

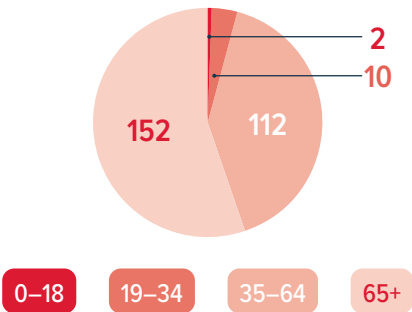
- Rehabilitation Day Program (RDP)
an intense, coordinated outpatient program
- Traditional Outpatient (OP)
Physical, Occupational and/or Speech
Therapy 1-3 times per week. Rehabilitation
Psychology available.
- Specialty Clinics and Assessments
specialized services focused on areas such
as vision, swallowing, wheelchair mobility,
communication or long term follow-up.

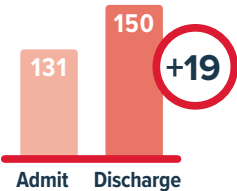
